Item Action / Decision

Welcomes, Introductions and Explanation

JMD explained to all residents that had gathered that we could not use the Community Hall to hold the meeting to discuss and vote over the banning of resident **NW** by the previous NPRA Committee.

JMD asked **LN** if the Luncheon Club could be opened to host the meeting, and she discussed with **AB** but it was not made available. Due to the number of elderly, and one mobile impaired resident, **JMD** believed to reschedule the meeting would be unfair to those that had gathered to a meeting that they expected to be held and there was not enough time to inform them that it had to be cancelled.

JMD briefly outlined his own views on **NW** banning in that the proper procedure was not followed and if the meeting could be hosted in the Community Hall (or elsewhere), residents would be able to hear the background of the ban and ask questions to **NW** directly. Unfortunately, this could not occur and **JMD** recommended that the residents should go directly to a vote in retaining the ban or overturning it, as most of the residents present knew of **NW** situation and had personally spoken to her directly after the May AGM. **JMD** mentioned the posters that had been put up on all the outside notice boards and in many of the Nightingale blocks outlining the topic of discussion of the meeting more than two weeks before.

SA asked the gathered residents if the meeting should go ahead instead of being rescheduled. It went to a show of hands vote and the majority wanted the vote over **NW** ban to take place.

A vote by a show of hands then took place. The results:

For overturning the ban: 12

To retain the ban: 6

Abstained: 2

JMD welcomed back to **NW** to the NPRA. Announced that the next NPRA meeting would be on Wednesday, 24th October.
